## Key terms

Term	Explanation
<b>Interment right</b>	Gives the interment right holder the exclusive right to inter human remains at a specified site, either for a specified time or in perpetuity. In the past, this might have been called a burial right, reservation or a similar term. The listed price is what you will pay for the right over the site only. It does not include the cost of interring remains, which will be listed in the burial or ash interment rows.
<b>Interment of remains</b>	The placement of bodily human remains below ground or in specialised above-ground structures like vaults or mausoleums. The listed price is what you will pay for the burial to take place.
<b>Interment of ashes</b>	The placement of cremated human remains in a grave or other memorial structure. The listed price is what you are paying for the ash interment to take place.
<b>Cremation</b>	A process for the reduction of bodily remains, usually by fire or heat. The listed price is what you will pay for the cremation to take place.
<b>Additional fees and charges</b>	Only mandatory additional charges are listed here. Common additional charges might include monuments (if included in the least expensive package) or government fees like the interment service levy.

## Relationship between these prices and prices charged

This document shows the least expensive options available to you. You can choose other options that may be more expensive. Whatever you choose, you must be provided with a contract that breaks down the price of the chosen option in the same way as these prices.

### What about costs charged by other parties?

The prices shown here and in your contract with the cemetery or crematorium operator may not include costs for services provided by other parties. For example, some cemetery operators may contract out site preparation to a third party. You should ask the operator or funeral director about whether there will be any mandatory charges to pay to another party.

### What if I am buying an interment service pre-need?

If you are buying an interment service pre-need, you may not pay all these amounts upfront. For example, it is common practice to charge the interment right price now and the interment price at the time of need. For the purposes of pricing transparency and ease of comparison, all elements of the price are included here regardless of the timing of required payment.
